Tasks include making copies of birth certificates, recruiting coaches, handing out forms, assisting parents with sign up for Skills Assessment, etc. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 1-3 hours per Registration session</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Skills Assessment Check-In: Volunteers are needed to check in participants and hand out pinnies. This task can be shared by multiple volunteers in small 1 or 2-hour shifts. Specify the Skills Assessment day/time you can assist with check in here: _____ <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 1-3 hours</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Distribution Assistants: This requires a team of volunteers to assist with distribution of various items from a central location. Whether it's photo orders, uniforms or trophies, we need reliable individuals to assist with the distribution of items throughout the season. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: Approximately 1 hour (more or less, depending on number of volunteers)</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Referees: Referees are needed for the U7, U8, U10 and U12 games every week. You will be provided with the laws of the game for each age group (and training if required), as well as a referee shirt and equipment. If you have played soccer or are familiar with the laws of the game, please submit a Volunteer Application (which is available at registration or on the website). Email our Referee Administrator for additional information. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 1 hour per week</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Referee Administrator (Scheduler): This volunteer would be responsible for scheduling the volunteer referees for games each week. You will be responsible for creating a schedule for the season and distributing and managing the referee equipment and schedule. No experience with refereeing is required for this position. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 2-3 hours</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>"Field of Dreams" Team: If you love geometry, this is the job for you. A team of volunteers is required to initially set up the 5 fields before the weekly marking can be done. We will provide the dimensions, layout and equipment (stakes, string, paint machine, etc.)--this task must be done prior to the first practice of the season. Volunteers are also needed to assemble and repair goals throughout the season. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 2-3 hours</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Field Lining: Every Thursday or Friday during the season, the fields will need to be marked. We provide the equipment, you provide the effort. It is simple and will take about an hour each week. You just have to trace over the existing lines. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 1 hour per week</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Rec Center Maintenance: This reliable volunteer must open the parking lot and restroom facilities at the Rec. Center every Saturday by 8:30 a.m. during the season. Remove trash, tidy and lock up facilities and parking lot after the last game every Saturday during the season. <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: 45 minutes per week</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Transportation Vehicles: Otherwise known as "Men With Trucks", we need volunteers with pick up trucks, vans or SUV's to help with transporting equipment such as goals (small and large), team equipment, uniforms, etc. Ladies with muscles and suitable vehicles are welcome to volunteer too! <i>Estimated Volunteer Time: Varies according to tasks.</i></p>
